CHILD FIND INFORMATION

The purpose of this notification is to ensure that the Milford School Department is in compliance with 05-071 Chapter 101 Maine Unified Special Education Regulation, Birth to Age Twenty.

“Each SAU shall maintain and implement policies and procedures to ensure that all children residing in the jurisdiction between the ages of 3 and 20 years, including children with disabilities who are homeless children, are wards of the State or state agency clients, children with disabilities attending private schools and receiving home instruction, highly mobile children (including migrant or homeless), children who have the equivalent of 10 full days of unexcused absences or 7 consecutive school days of unexcused absences during a school year, and children incarcerated in county jails, and who are in need of special education and related services, even though they are advancing from grade to grade, are identified, located and evaluated at public expense.”

It is the stated intention of the Milford School Department to provide any eligible special education student for whom it has responsibility, a “genuine opportunity for equitable participation” in special education programs.
