

Detention

The principal and teachers may assign students detention as a consequence for unacceptable behavior. In order to ensure that detention is effective, all those involved need to be fully informed.

Detention is to be given as soon as possible after the occurrence which led to it. Before having a student serve detention, the principal or teacher must contact a parent of the student to inform them of the situation. The student will then be assigned detention that same day, if possible.

It is the responsibility of the principal or teacher to assure, before detention is held, that parents have made arrangements to transport the students home after detention.
