Dear Parents/Guardians,

With April break coming up, if you plan to travel outside of Maine, please remember that New Hampshire, Vermont, Connecticut, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island are currently the only states exempt from restrictions under Governor Mill's executive order. Due to the executive order requirements, your child will need to receive a negative COVID test or quarantine for 10 days prior to returning to school. If you are traveling internationally during break please speak with the school nurse about requirements before returning to school. If you are traveling during the break, please let the school nurse know so she can help monitor the fulfillment of the requirements.
